Legacy Foundation for the Arts, Inc. awards scholarships in piano, voice, musical theatre and dance for intensive study programs. All programs must be approved by Legacy Foundation for the Arts, Inc.

Scholarships vary in amount. The maximum amount awarded will be \$1,000. Applicants must be between the ages of 12 and 22 (inclusive) by June 1, 2023 **and** reside or attend school within a 75 mile radius of Kansas City. All completed materials must be postmarked by February 15, 2023.

Applicants must notify Legacy Foundation for the Arts of all financial assistance given to the applicant to attend the selected program (as well as the source(s)). Amounts awarded will not exceed the cost of the program.

All applicants must audition in the area of specialization of the intensive/college major. For example, if planning to attend a ballet intensive, one's video audition must contain the ballet criteria. An applicant may not submit an application using one set of criteria yet attend a program of a different discipline (e.g., submit jazz yet attend a ballet intensive); however, an applicant may submit more than one discipline for consideration if desired.

Notification of decisions will be mailed in April. If selected, the scholarship award will be sent directly to the program in the name of the recipient. The award must be used by December 31, 2023.

Founded in August 2003, Legacy Foundation for the Arts, Inc. provides enrichment, education and outreach programs for the public as well as support and encouragement for those pursuing advancement in the arts. As of September 2022, more than 200 students have received more than \$155,000 in scholarships for intensive study.
